MURAL AS TOOL TO ENCOURAGE BETTER PUBLIC SANITATION AS PART OF BANDUNG CITY PARK BRANDING

The delevelopment of the Public Park by the Municipal Government of Bandung City has many advantages for the residents of Bandung. A Place for the residence to get to gather, a culture hub and as a medium to convey information from the government to the public. Information that could be transmitted in a more casual manner. Thus, making it more of an enrouragement rather than a regulation. Encouragement such as public sanitation will be more acceptable to the public if it is conveyed in this way. Rather than using regulation and punishment to enforce the idea. This was the case of Public Park in Kelurahan batununggal. Through the usage of murals as one of the key fiture in a park. Encouragement information can be shown in a aesthetic and visually pleasing manner.

The outcome of this project is to create a Mural that has an encouragement message of better waste management and better sanitation habits of the residence of kelurahan Batununggal. An information, rather than regulation, is non intimidating and more acceptable to the public. In doing so, the public will voluntarily develop better sanitation habbit.

1. INTRODUCTION

Bandung is one of Indonesia's vibrant cities which has a culturally rich people. Bandung are also synonymous with urban innovation, as its people are attributed for their creativity in developing the urban space. Dub as the "Paris van Java" for its beautiful landscape and artistic culture, Bandung has embarked on a journey to redefine its identity as Indonesia's creative hub by reshaping its urban area to enhance the for its residence and visitor alike. One of the tools to achieve this is by using mural as a mean to encourage for better public sanitation. One of the crucial aspects of Bandung City Park Initiative.

The City Park Initiative is a program that are aimed at not only to elevate the aesthetic quality of the urban landscape but also fostering the civic responsibility of the resident. By recognizing the positive impact of art and aesthetics has on Bandung's resident the program aims nurturing better behaviour towards the city itself. One of the key tool to achieve this is by strategically using Mural as a catalyst for change.

One of the area that are targeted for the City Park Initiative is the Kelurahan of Batununggal. An area that are situated in the south of Bandung and has parks that haven't been redesigned to meet the new standard. One particular park is the park near an motorcycle taxi stop that is adjacent to a moderate size river. At it currant state this park is under develop and urgently needed a redesign in order to for it to function as a proper park for the nearby the residence.

In this paper we will explore the fascinating role that mural will play to encourage better public satitation for Bandung's vibrant and complex resident. This paper will explain the step and process that the designer took on designing the mural to convey the message of better public sanitation for the residence of Kelurahan Batununggal, one of the kelurahan in The City of Bandung. This paper will also explore the use of design method such as Framing and Aestehtic Usability Effect (Lidwell, Holden, Butler, 2003) in the design decision that the designer took.

In the year 2022, the Public Relation Office of The City of Bandung stated that this city has about 759 parks with roughly the size of 2 million square meters (citarumharum, 2022). These parks are divided among the 30 kecamatan that make up the city of Bandung. 10 of those parks are in the kecamatan of Bandung Kidul, specifically the

kelurahan of Batununggal (opendata, 2020). This park needs repair dan redesign. Its urgently needed an artistic touct to elevate it aesthetic to please and encourage its residence to use the park as a communal area.

The mural will feature the suggestion of better sanitation manner such as propper waste management of the residence in Bandung, especially in Kelurahan Batununggal.

2. METHOD

The mechanism that will be carried out are the usage of hand drawn sketch that will be overlay with acrylic paint wich are water base. So, it will not pollute the the surrounding area of the park. The drawing will be drawn in cartoon style dwaring with the intention of making the information more audience friendly. So, the audience, wich is the nearby residence, will not have the perception of being told to do but rather being suggested, encourage to make better satitation behaviour in term of waste management.

The process begin with the designing of a paper dwarn sketch wich are shown to the kelurahan leaders. The participation of local leader is important. Because they cloud represent the local voice of the area. Below is shown the design sketch that had been drawn in the designing stage.



3. RESULT AND DISCUSSION

4. CONCLUSION

Upon completion of the mural, the team foun several technical chalangges. Such as the usage of multiplex wood presents the challenge of water seeping into the pores of the wood. This was the side effect of using acrilyc paint that is water base. This causes the wood to develop bulges in several parts of the surface. Secondly the viscosily of the paint will cause a different effect (an unwanted rough surface) of the paint. This made the team to be more carefully mixing the pintwith water. The best mixture of water is paint is 1:10 mix.

After its completion the mural was handed over to the official of Kelurahan Batununggal. After consideration the official decided to move the mural from the original spot, which is adjacent to the river, to a more accessible place. That is infront of the kelurahn office. Saveral suggestention was given by the team regarding the option of spot. Given the fact that the material that was used are wood, that are prone to rotting away by the weather, the kelurahan official should consider masking the mural with a thin layer og clear coat oh transparan paint. To Preserve the color and over all form of the mural. Overall, the project was a success with the ontime completion and the acchived overall design quality.

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
